POSITION TITLE AND DEPARTMENT/DIVISION:

Emergency Trauma Technician (ETT). Four positions are available.

POSITION LOCATION:

Saint Paul Island, Alaska.

POSITION CLASSIFICATION AND HOURS:

On-Call; Hours may vary.

JOB SUMMARY:

The Emergency Trauma Technician (ETT) responds to emergency calls to provide efficient and immediate care to the critically ill and injured, and to transport the patient to the health center.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

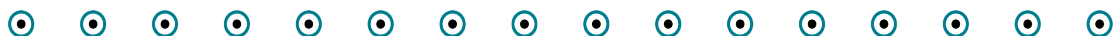
1. Responding to EMS calls for service 24/7 (including nights, weekends, and holidays).
2. Respond to all EMS, fire, medevac, and rescue calls, and provide medical care and treatment at the level of certification in emergent and non-emergent settings.
3. Examine and evaluate patients to determine necessary care.
4. Document patient information, condition, and treatment.
5. Maintain patient confidentiality and perform all care with respect for patient rights.
6. Transport patients to health center.
7. Operate and drive ambulance in conjunction with applicable safety policies and laws.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
2. Must possess a valid Alaska Driver's License or ability to obtain within thirty (30) days from date of hire. Must have a clean driving record.
3. Must be a team player.
4. Communicate effectively with Public Safety personnel, the public and other external contacts on two-way radio or in person.
5. Provide assistance with lifting patients when needed.
6. Must abide by the City of Saint Paul's alcohol and drug free workplace policies and submit to a pre-employment drug and alcohol test.
7. Must abide by the City Employee COVID-19 Vaccination Policy, by being fully vaccinated for COVID-19 prior to employment with the City.
8. Other combinations of education and experience which could provide the knowledge, skills and abilities listed will be evaluated on an individual basis.

WAGE:

The wage for this position \$25.08 per hour.
